



VAUCLUSE FACTORY YARD



Saint Thomas, Barbados

Sitting towards the entrance of the Vaucluse Factory yard over 800 feet above sea level in the parish of St. Thomas is this large old factory building that has been used as a furniture manufacturing workshop for over 25 years. It forms part of the old Vaucluse sugar factory that ceased operation over forty years ago.

The main house and some of the old factory buildings have been restored or converted into private residences that ooze charm and character with a blend of modern everyday comforts cleverly integrated onto the old stone walls of the original buildings.

The workshop boasts high ceilings supported by thick coral stone walls with a massive open concrete floor area. A wooden mezzanine office sitting above the bathroom and storeroom sit in one corner with three large pairs of wooden doors leading out to the front entrance and two side entrances. One of these pairs of doors leads to the side of the building with access to the rear of the building where the large concrete water tank is located, and the other leads out to a grass area that would make an attractive private lawn or recreational area.

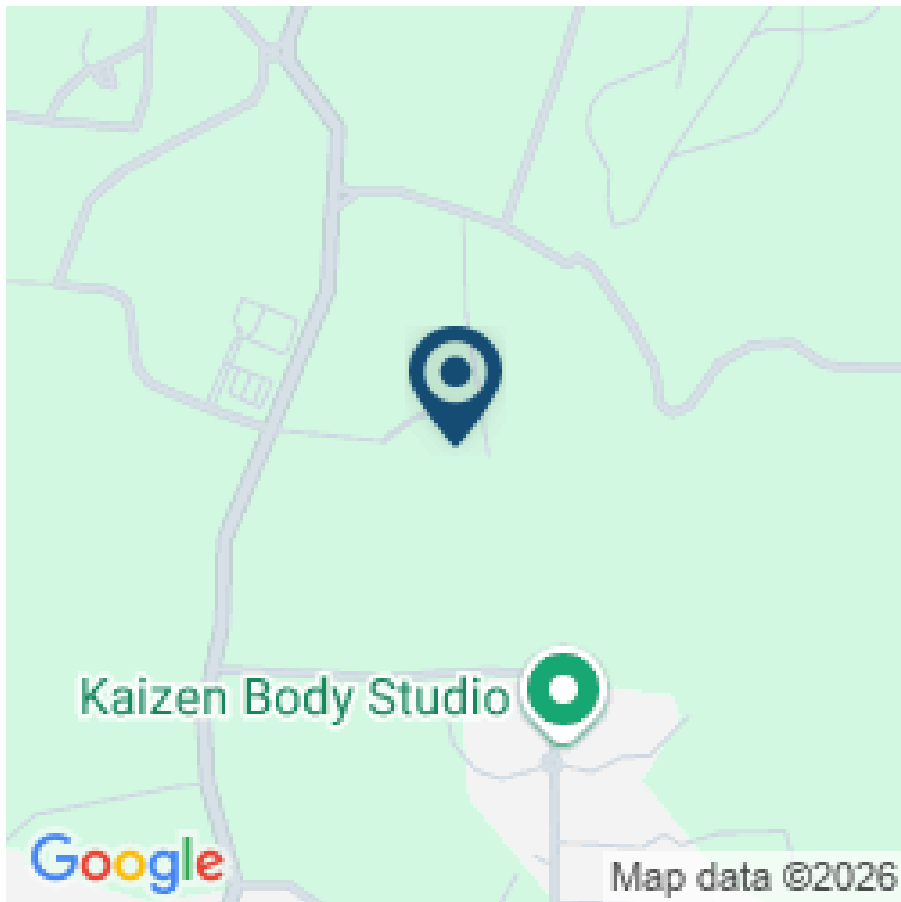
